

What needs to *CHANGE* so that next time won't be like last time?

What needs to change in me to make sure that next time isn't like last time?

1. THE EXPERIENCE MYTH

When a wise person sees danger ahead, he avoids it. But a foolish person keeps going and gets into trouble. Proverbs 22:3

**As a dog returns to its vomit, so a fool repeats his foolishness.
Proverbs 26:11**

It isn't experience that makes us wiser.

It is evaluated experience that makes us wiser.

2. THE KNOW BETTER MYTH

**The heart is deceitful above all things and it is extremely sick; Who can understand it fully *and* know its secret motives?
Jeremiah 17:9**

We don't just make choices with our head.

We also make choices with our heart.

We trade momentary pleasure for lasting pain.

Romans 7:18-21

18 I want to do what is right, but I can't. **19** I want to do what is good, but I don't. I don't want to do what is wrong, but I do it anyway. **20** But if I do what I don't want to do, I am not really the one doing wrong; it is sin living in me that does it. **21** I have discovered this principle of life—that when I want to do what is right, I inevitably do what is wrong.

Romans 8:11-14

11 The Spirit of God, who raised Jesus from the dead, lives in you. And just as God raised Christ Jesus from the dead, he will give life to your mortal bodies by this same Spirit living within you. **12** Therefore, dear brothers and sisters, you have no obligation to do what your sinful nature urges you to do. **13** For if you live by its dictates, you will die. But if through the power of the Spirit you put to death the deeds of your sinful nature, you will live. **14** For all who are led by the Spirit of God are children of God.

3. THE TIME MYTH
