- 3. What is your greatest barrier to acting on God's plans?
- 4. Doing the right thing isn't always the easy thing to do. Share about a time where you did the right thing even though it was hard. What was the result?
- 5. **Read Haggai 1:7-8.** Based on the three steps God gives Israel, what might the three steps look like in your life?
- 6. Pastor Josh said, "You have to do what God shows you first before He shows you what is next." Why do you think God only shows us one step at a time instead of showing us the whole plan all at once? Is getting God's plan one step at a time frustrating or comforting for you?
- 7. In what areas of your life do you struggle being obedient to God?
