(2) Starving Sons

HOW do we RECOVER our FUTURE... When we've TRADED IT AWAY for something so FLEETING and FUTILE!? Genesis 25:24-34... When the time came for her to give birth, there were twin boys in her womb. The first to come out was red, and his whole body was like a hairy garment; so they named him Esau. After this, his brother came out, with his hand grasping Esau's heel; so he was named Jacob. Isaac was sixty years old when Rebekah gave birth to them. The boys grew up, and **Esau** became a skillful hunter, a man of the open country, while **Jacob** was content to stay at home among the tents. **Isaac**, who had a taste for wild game, loved **Esau**, but **Rebekah** loved **Jacob**. Once when **Jacob** was cooking some stew, **Esau** came in from the open country, famished. He said to Jacob, "Quick, let me have some of that red stew! I'm famished!" Jacob replied, "First sell me your birthright." "Look, I am about to die," **Esau** said. "What good is the birthright to me?" But **Jacob** said, "Swear to me first." So he swore an oath to him, selling his birthright to Jacob. Then Jacob gave Esau some bread and some lentil stew. He ate and drank, and then got up and left. So Esau despised his birthright. THREE PRIMARY CAUTIONS... 1. Beware of mistaking **GROWTH** for **MATURITY**! Verse 27... THE BOYS GREW UP... and Esau became a skillful hunter, a man of the open country, while Jacob was content to stay at home among the tents. Esau got REALLY GOOD at WHAT he DID ... but didn't get REALLY GOOD at WHO he WAS! ...and Esau became a skillful hunter Meaning... He got REALLY GOOD at KILLING HIS DINNER ... but NEVER GOT GOOD at CONTROLLING HIS APPETITE! Verse 28... Isaac who had a taste for wild game... loved Esau - but Rebekah loved Jacob.

Verses 29-30...

Once when Jacob was cooking some stew, Esau came in from the open country, famished. He said to Jacob, "Quick, let me have some of that red stew! I'm famished!"
You have to be VERY CAREFUL when you are VUNERABLE WHO YOU REACH OUT TO for HELP for ADVICE or for GUIDANCE because if you REACH OUT to the WRONG PERSON the WRONG VOICE YOU'LL MAKE THE WRONG CHOICE EVERYTIME!
Verse 31 Jacob replied, "First sell me your birthright."
"Quick, let me have some of that red stew! I'm famished!"
THREE PRIMARY CAUTIONS
2. Beware of UNSATISFIED APPETITES that become EXAGGERATED EMOTIONS!
Verse 32 "Look, I am about to die," Esau said. "What good is the birthright to me?"
BEWARE friends in your quests and endeavors in life that you don't get TOO HUNGRY!
WHAT A HORRIBLE TRADE A BOWL of BEANS for a BIRTHRIGHT!?
Verse 34 Then Jacob gave Esau some bread and some lentil stew. He ate and drank, and then got up and left.
So Esau despised his birthright.
THREE PRIMARY CAUTIONS
3. Beware of the temptation to give up what you want MOST for what you want NOW !

TESTIMONY...

Matthew 5:16...

In the same way, **let your LIGHT shine before others**, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven.

BOWLS... FOR BIRTHRIGHTS!

Hebrews 12:16-17...

See that no one is sexually immoral, or is **GODLESS**... **LIKE ESAU**... who for a **SINGLE MEAL**... **sold his inheritance rights** as the oldest son. Afterward, as you know, when he wanted to inherit this blessing, he was rejected. Even though he sought the blessing **with tears**, **he could not change what he had done**.

Romans 8:29...

For those God foreknew... he also predestined... to be conformed to the image of his Son - that **He** might be the **FIRSTBORN...** among many brothers and sisters.
