(2) Three Roles Of Parenting

OFFENSIVE PARENTING is really about...

PREPARING rather than **PROTECTING!**

The QUESTIONS You Really Need To Be Asking...

ARE YOU RAISING A CHILD... (or...) ARE YOU PREPARING A FUTURE ADULT?

WHAT ARE YOU DOING RIGHT NOW THAT IS ANTICIPATING WHAT THEY "NEED TO KNOW" BEFORE... THAT "NEED" EVER COMES?

In other words...

What are you doing NOW... to PREPARE THEM for THEN?

THREE PRIMARY ROLES IN OFFENSIVE PARENTING...

1. GROUNDSKEEPER

This is where we **DEFINE** the **RULES/BOUNDARIES!**

2. REFEREE

This is where we **ENFORCE** the **RULES/BOUNDARIES!**

3. COACH

This is where we CONTINUALLY TEACH the RULES/BOUNDARIES!

DISCIPLINE is what you do **FOR** you Children... so they will be

PREPARED for when you're **NOT IN THE ROOM** later in their life!

PUNISHMENT is what you do **TO** your Children... to satisfy your **FRUSTRATION**!

1. GROUNDSKEEPER

GROUNDSKEEPING is where we DEFINE what our CHILD... CAN and/or CAN'T DO!

PROVERBS 29:15...

The **Rod of Correction** imparts **Wisdom**, but a **child left undisciplined** - disgraces its mother.

The Role of the GROUNDSKEEPER is to...

DEFINE THE FIELD OF PLAY!

Don't mistake PRECEDENCE (Biblical) with PREFERENCE (Personal)!

2. REFEREE

REFEREEING is where/when we ENFORCE the RULES/BOUNDARIES!

PROVERBS 13:24...

He who spares the **ROD** hates his son... but he who **LOVES HIM** is careful to **DISCIPLINE** him!

When Your Child has CROSSED THE LINE... BROKEN A CLEARLY
MARKED BOUNDARY... DISOBEYED A RULE... YOU HAVE TO THROW
THE FLAG... YOU HAVE TO ENFORCE THE PENALTY!

BIG PENALTIES need to be reserved for ATTITUDE... not for ACTIONS!

The most important PENALTIES to call are PENALTIES OF THE HEART!

When we Discipline CONSISTENTLY... we Discipline with WISDOM!

Proverbs 29:15... The Rod of Correction... IMPARTS WISDOM!

3. COACH

COACHING is when we continually TEACH/TRAIN our Children the RULES/BOUNDARIES!

PROVERBS 22:6...

TRAIN a child in the way he should go and when he is old he will not turn from it!
