GROUP DISCUSSION...

1. **READ Nehemiah 1:4-11.** Share about a time when God broke your heart for someone or some situation. How did you respond?
2. Pastor Josh said, “*The **Church** that discovers that **God** wants **WORSHIPPERS** before **WORKERS**... will realize that **INTIMACY** with **Him** - **ALWAYS** precedes **ACTIVITY** with **Him**.*” What happens to the church when we prioritize activity over intimacy? What do you do personally to prioritize intimacy with Jesus over activity for Jesus? What spiritual practices help you connect best with Jesus?
3. For what purpose do you think God brought you specifically to COC right now?
4. **READ Hebrews 10:24-25.** What are you doing to, “*encourage one another to outbursts of love and good deeds*”? What could you be doing?
5. Pastor Josh said, “*We need to see the need, feel the need, share the need, and meet the need.*” What are the needs that you see in Maricopa? How is God calling you to meet those needs?
6. Pastor Josh said, “*GIVING AND SERVING ARE NOT ABOUT WHAT GOD WANTS FROM YOU... IT’S WHAT HE WANTS FOR YOU!*” Share about a time when you gave or served and you received more than you gave.
7. **READ Matthew 28:18-20.** Who have you shared your faith with or invited to COC recently? How did it go? What are creative ways that you can start spiritual conversations or invite people to COC?
8. How can we pray for you this week?
