ICE-BREAKER...

GROUP DISCUSSION...

- 1. Talk about a time when you were treated unfairly, in either a big way or a small way. How did you respond? What was the result?
- 2. When have you seen God allow injustice in your world? What did that do to or for your faith in God? Did that influence your understanding of God at all?
- 3. Have you ever seen someone who was suffering extremely, but they had extreme confidence in God? If so, how did that impact your view of suffering and faith?
- 4. Why do we naturally assume that if there is a God He must be good and just?
- 5. Pastor Josh said, "When we **REJECT GOD** because of all the **INJUSTICE** in the **World** we don't **SOLVE INJUSTICE**. WE LOSE THE DEFINITION altogether!" Do you agree or disagree with this statement? Why?
- 6. **Read Luke 18:7-8**. Is it difficult to believe that one day God will bring justice to every injustice in the world? Why or why not?
- 7. Do you struggle with evil an injustice in the world? What is one thing you can do this week to embrace Jesus, the man whose definition of good and just informs your understanding of what is good and just?
